With the support of ACCESS to Health Fund, MHAA implement "CpA-TB project" in 14 townships of Yangon to be served the activities of community based active case finding on drug sensitive TB patients, evening DOT provision on drug resistant TB patients and also provide MDR-TB care in Decentralized sites in Yangon.

Project Goal

To reduce the burden of drug sensitive TB by conducting active case finding and providing DOTS supervision by volunteer and that of drug resistant TB by serving MDR-TB care at DC sites in Yangon.

Project Objectives

1. To mobilize and empower communities to prevent and reduce the burden of tuberculosis
2. To promote access to early diagnosis and prompt treatment for Tuberculosis
3. To sustain and improve the quality of DOTS services to reach all TB patients and thereby to improve the treatment success rate among all TB detected patients
4. To support the treatment success of MDR TB patients while ensuring infection control and prevention of Tuberculosis

Position Summary

To conduct series of clinical consultation and counseling sessions to identify magnitude of MDR-TB patients who require interventions and a way of appropriate psychological / psychiatric service delivery by TB program under the supervision and guidance of **Senior Consultant (TB) NTP Central (Yangon Branch)**.

- ❖ To provide a series of lectures and feedback to health workers who directly see patients to develop their capacity to identify problem.
- ❖ To develop a proposal to state essential and ideal needs of psychological / psychiatric support to MDR-TB patients in Yangon to develop a concrete HR plan.
- ❖ Perform any other duties as required and assigned by NTP.
